All kids who are potty trained up to kids who are going into 6th grade this fall are welcome. Kids need to bring a sack lunch and snacks will be provided.

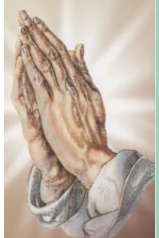

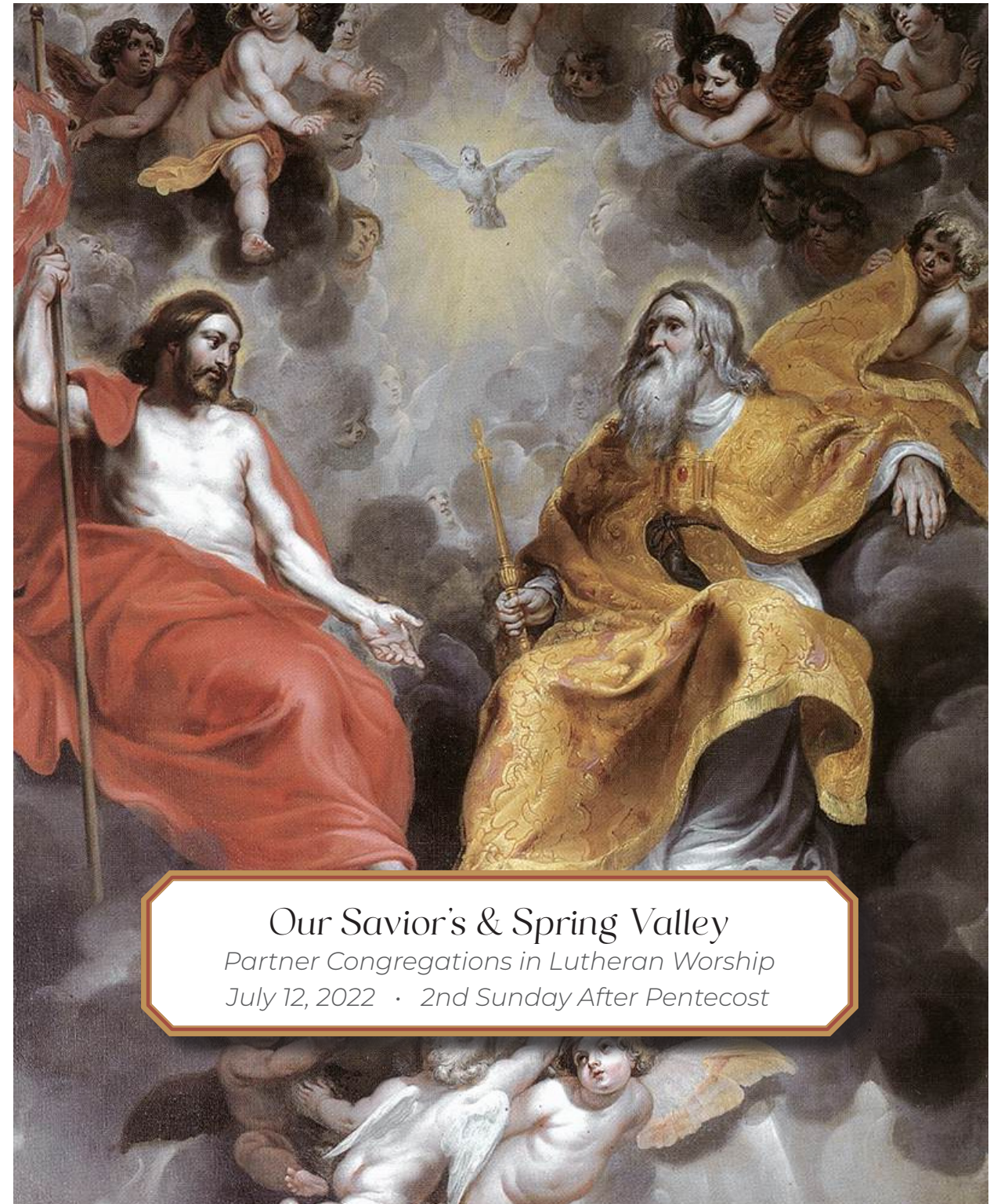

8 Does not wisdom call? Does not understanding raise her voice? ² On the heights beside the way, at the crossroads she takes her stand; ³ beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries aloud: ⁴ “To you, O men, I call, and my cry is to the children of man.
