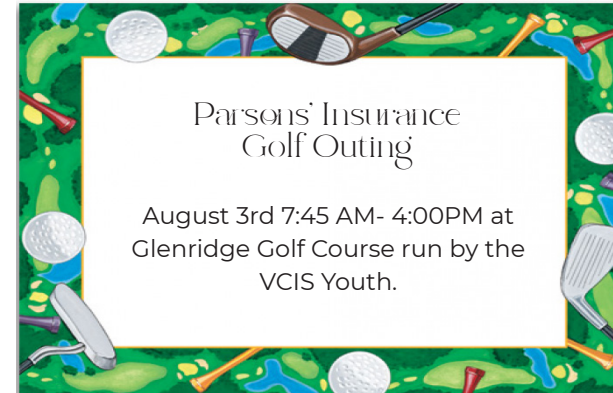
How it Works

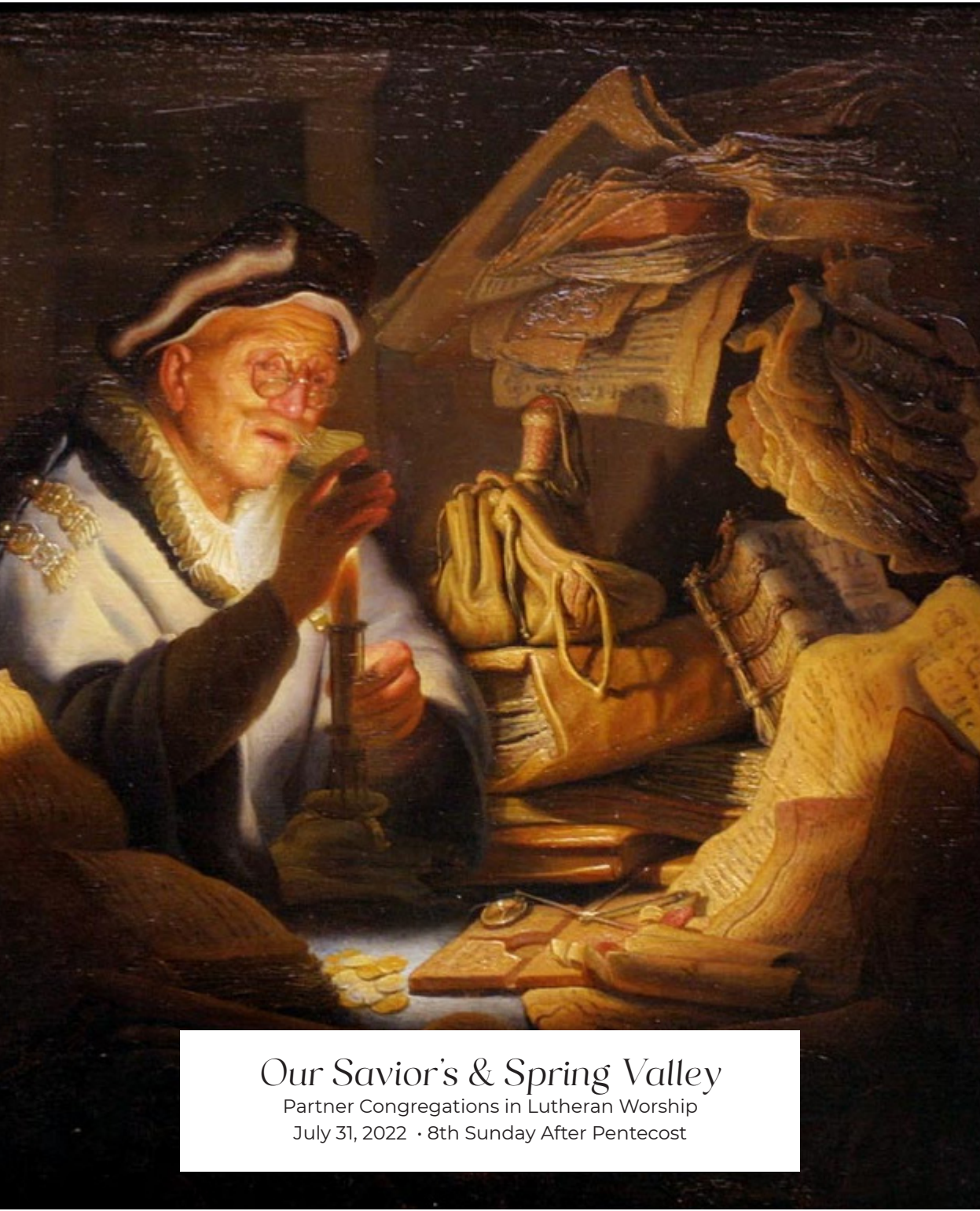
