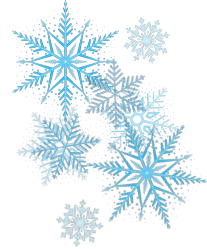

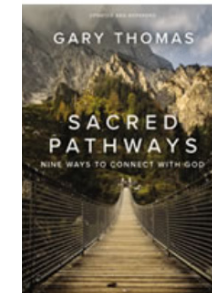

First Reading ..... Jonah 3:1-5, 10
